3- Legal aspects

Statutes: One proposition, with options:

- Only one ASBL
- Choice between W/XL solutions for membership
- 1 month for calling for a GM
- 3 procurations max
- 2/3 majority for changing internal rules
- Board members: minimum: 2 per LS + 3, max: 21
- Elections to the Board : Choice between W/XL for elections during the GM or by LS; for total or partial renewal of the Board
- President's Mandate: 4+2
- Bureau : +2 odd members; mandatory delegation of 'gestion journalière'.
