
THE OFFICE (Building S)

TRANSPORT

THE TEAM

First phase of enrolment defines the routes and stops (June 30, 2025)

When enrolling after June 30 you will be allocated a stop on an existing line. Definitive detailed bus routes are published in late August.

WHEN?

- > MORNING: Arrival at school between 7:45 AM and 8:05 AM (54 buses)
- > AFTERNOON: 2 departures (58 buses) on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday

3:20 PM (PM1 with priority given for M1 to P5) and

4:10 PM (PM2 for secondary students)

- > WEDNESDAYS NOON: Departure for all (49 buses) → 12:50 PM (buses to garderies leave at 1:30 PM)
- > FRIDAY LUNCHTIME: Only for students from M1 to P2, buses to garderies and merode

Extracurricular related: possiblity to use 2nd departure after extracurricular activities subject to seat availability



HOW LONG?

- > Journey times depend on the routes, the number of stops (+/-350) and the brussels traffic!
- > The transport office tries to keep transport times to an average of 1h in the morning and 1h30 on the return trips.

If you are registered with the APEEE you can have access to the bus schedules and stops for the current year.

WHO?

- > 11 different bus companies
- > A monitor, either adult or 16+ EEB4 student, in each bus (around 90 bus monitors in total)

FORMULA (available for 35 students)


> 100%: Home-school-home or home-school-garderie AM and PM

HOW MUCH?

- > Price for the school year 2024-2025 was:
 - 2.167,88 € (100%)
- > Paid in 3 instalments (each trimester)
- > Some Institutions reimburse check with your employer

WHAT?

- > **Healthy** and **environmentally friendly food** prepared in our kitchen
- > Menus are being published for the whole month with allergy information

HOW OFTEN?

For nursery and primary pupils, it is mandatory to register for 3 or 4 days per week (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday or Friday).

For secondary students, it is mandatory to register for a minimum of 2 days per week.

For Wednesday registrations:

•Nursery and Primary students:

Pupils enrolled in OIB child care centers benefit from a canteen meal covered in the child care cost.

•Secondary students: As places being limited, secondary students who have lessons in the afternoon have priority.
