Summer Camp 2026: the manual

Once again, the extracurricular service is organising a summer camp for students from S1 to S3 from June 22 to July 2, 2026!

Save the date: registrations open on Tuesday, 24 March 2026 at 10 AM!

Program:

❖ SUMMER CAMP

Students will have the choice between 8 camps:

- **Sports camp (70 places) FULL:** This camp offers students the opportunity to discover a wide variety of sports disciplines: climbing, Parkour, taekwondo, rugby, capoeira, athletics, wrestling, etc...
- **Football camp (14 places) FULL:** A 100% football course. Perfect for students wishing to perfect their technique, develop their team game and thrive on the field.
- **NEW - Judo camp (14 places):** This new camp combines judo classes in the morning and an introduction to martial arts in the afternoon, for students who wish a complete introduction to combat sports.
- **Art camp (14 places):** This camp offers a mix of artistic and creative activities such as sculpture, pottery, painting and other surprises. For students who want to discover the artist in them.
- **NEW - Digital Art camp (14 places):** This camp offers the opportunity to explore different forms of digital creation, such as image, animation and creative coding. Visiting a museum as well as participating in a workshop is on the program.
- **Coding camp (14 places):** This camp allows students to design video games with Godot Engine! They will learn to code in GD script, a language very close to Python. It is the ideal tool to acquire good programming skills and turn game ideas into reality.

This camp is aimed at all levels: a common theoretical basis and optional extensions and challenges for more advanced students.

- **NEW - Chess Camp (14 places)**: This new camp combines chess in the morning and sports activities in the afternoon. It is perfect for students who want to develop their strategic skills and will be useful to them well beyond the chessboard. They will have the opportunity to meet and play against a chess champion, and a tournament will be organized to close the camp.
- **NEW –Showtime camp (14 places)**: This new camp offers a mix of singing, dance and theatre classes for students who dream of becoming a star! It is inspired by the French tv show Star Academy and aims to introduce students to all facets of the world of entertainment.

The participants of these courses will have the chance to spend a day at the Aventure Parc in Wavre and another at Aqualibi!

On the last day, Thursday, July 2nd, a collective activity will be organised at the school!

❖ **MINI SUMMER CAMP**

This year two mini-camps (28 places) are offered from June 22 to 26, 2026 and from June 29 to July 2, 2026

On the program: various artistic activities, sports and other fun and creative experiences!

The students of these 2 camps will also participate in an outing!

❖ **SUMMER DAYS (25 + 26 June 2026)**

Two days of fun with diverse activities, including an outing.

Practical information:

- **Rates:**

Summer Camp: The price for the 9-day camp is: 375 €

Mini Summer Camp:

- Week 22 to 26 June 2026: The rate for the 5-day camp is: 275 €
- Week June 29 to July 2, 2026: The rate for the 4-day camp is: 220 €

Summer days (25 + 26 June 2026): the price for the 2 days of activities: 110 €

The meal is included in the price and will take place between 12:30 pm and 1:15 pm at the canteen (on the 3rd floor). During the days outside, a picnic (sandwich + dessert) will be prepared by the cafeteria, except at Aqualibi where the children will eat in one of the on-site restaurants. We strongly recommend that students bring a water bottle for the entire duration of the camp.

- Hours:

We invite the students to meet at the extracurricular meeting point (under the canteen) at 8:20 AM, to start the activities at 8:30 AM.

The day ends at 3:00 PM, except on Wednesday at 12:30 PM. If your child is enrolled in the transport service, he will therefore be able to take the 3:20 PM and 12:50 PM bus.

For students who are not registered to the transport service, the purchase of an occasional ticket on the [registration site](#) is possible, provided that places are available. Tickets must be purchased no later than 24 hours in advance.

Attention: during the two outings to Adventure Park and Aqualibi, the return time is scheduled at 5:00 PM, please pick up your child from school. The dates of the outings will be announced before the camp.

- Photos and videos:

To keep memories of this Summer Camp, photos and videos will be taken during the activities by the extracurricular service and by some of our partners. We will publish some of them on our APEEE website.

Pictures and videos taken by our partners will be shared with you and published on their website to promote their activities. If you do not want your child to be filmed or photographed, please notify us in the 'comment' box during registration.

- Registration Procedure:

Does your child wish to participate in the Summer Camp?

To register, please go to our registration site on Thursday, March 24th at 10 am, in the Extracurricular activities section and choose the title of the camp that interests you:

- Summer Camp 2026 - Sports Camp (Full)
- Summer Camp 2026 - Football Camp (Full)

Once your child's place is confirmed, you will receive an email inviting you to pay the amount corresponding to the chosen camp into the bank account of the extracurricular activity service. Please make this transfer within 2 weeks, otherwise your spot will no longer be guaranteed. We will not send a payment reminder.

IMPORTANT : families who are not members of APEEE as of 2025-2026 :

Families who are not members of the APEEE for the current school year must first apply for 2025-2026 and pay the membership before being able to register for the Summer Camp.

The payment of the membership fee is a mandatory condition to participate in the Summer Camp. The contribution conditions access to APEEE services. Any family in default of payment will see their order refused.

Please keep in mind that places are limited to 224 (168 for the 9-day Summer Camp, 28 for the Mini Summer Camps and 28 for the Summer Days).

The registrations are based on the '**first come, first served**' principle. After all the available places are booked, the following places will be placed on a waiting list. We will then contact you if a place is to become available.

Once the payment is made, you will receive an email confirming your child's registration for the Summer Camp.

- **Cancellation conditions:**

Registrations are strictly nominative; therefore, it is not possible to transfer a place assigned to one student to another.

The APEEE reserves the right to cancel one of the camps if a sufficient number of students is not reached.

Any cancellation request before the start of the Summer Camp must be justified. Reimbursement of the registration fee will only be accepted for cancellations submitted up to 3 working days before the start of the Summer Camp. After this period, no refund will be made.

Once the Summer Camp has started, only a medical certificate proving that it is impossible to continue the camp until its completion will justify a reimbursement request. In this case, the amount to be refunded will be calculated in proportion to the remaining days and excluding the tickets for outdoor outings.

- Constitution of the groups

The extracurricular team is responsible for setting up groups for each camp. This distribution is done randomly.

If your child wishes to be in the same group as another classmate, please mention it in the comment when registering.

The extracurricular service will do its utmost to meet these requests, but we cannot guarantee placement in the same group.

Regulation

- Security and discipline:

The school's regulations apply to the services provided by the APEEE. Children are required to demonstrate good conduct and to respect the equipment made available to them. Any damage to the equipment caused by a student during an activity will be charged to the parents.

Students are also responsible for their own belongings, especially any valuables they bring to the activity. For any forgotten or lost items, you are invited to contact the Eureka service: eureka@bru4.eu. The APEEE is neither responsible for lost or stolen objects, nor for damage caused to students' equipment. Students are advised to comply with the code of conduct and follow the instructor and APEEE instructions.

Students enrolled in the Summer Camp must wait for their instructor at the meeting point and cannot enter the activity room without permission.

The APEEE is not held responsible if a child does not show up at the Summer Camp.

For sports activities, students must wear appropriate shoes and clothing.

Harassment is in no way tolerated. Any incident of harassment will be immediately communicated to the Extracurricular team who will take appropriate measures.

Bringing dangerous objects (knives, knives, lasers, etc.) during the activities, apart from those allowed for medical reasons, is strictly prohibited for students and afterschool instructors. In addition, the Extracurricular Committee and/or the Extracurricular Office reserve(s) the right to take disciplinary measures, which may include exclusion from the activity or full camp against students who do not comply

with these provisions, and in particular if they are responsible for incidents putting the safety of other children, the instructor or any other person in danger. It should be noted that the exclusion from the service does not entitle to a refund for the camp.

- Illness and accident

Children, as long as they are on the school site, are covered by the school's insurance. Outside, they are covered by the insurance of the partner with whom the APEEE works.

Parents are required to inform the extracurricular service if the student suffers from a chronic illness or symptoms (allergy, asthma, diabetes, etc.).

In principle, no medication will be dispensed by the extracurricular staff.

In the event of an accident or injury during an activity, the extracurricular service will first contact the school infirmary (during opening hours) and inform the parents by phone or email. Outside the infirmary's opening hours, the service will contact the emergency services according to the situation and inform the parents by phone.
