THE BOARD



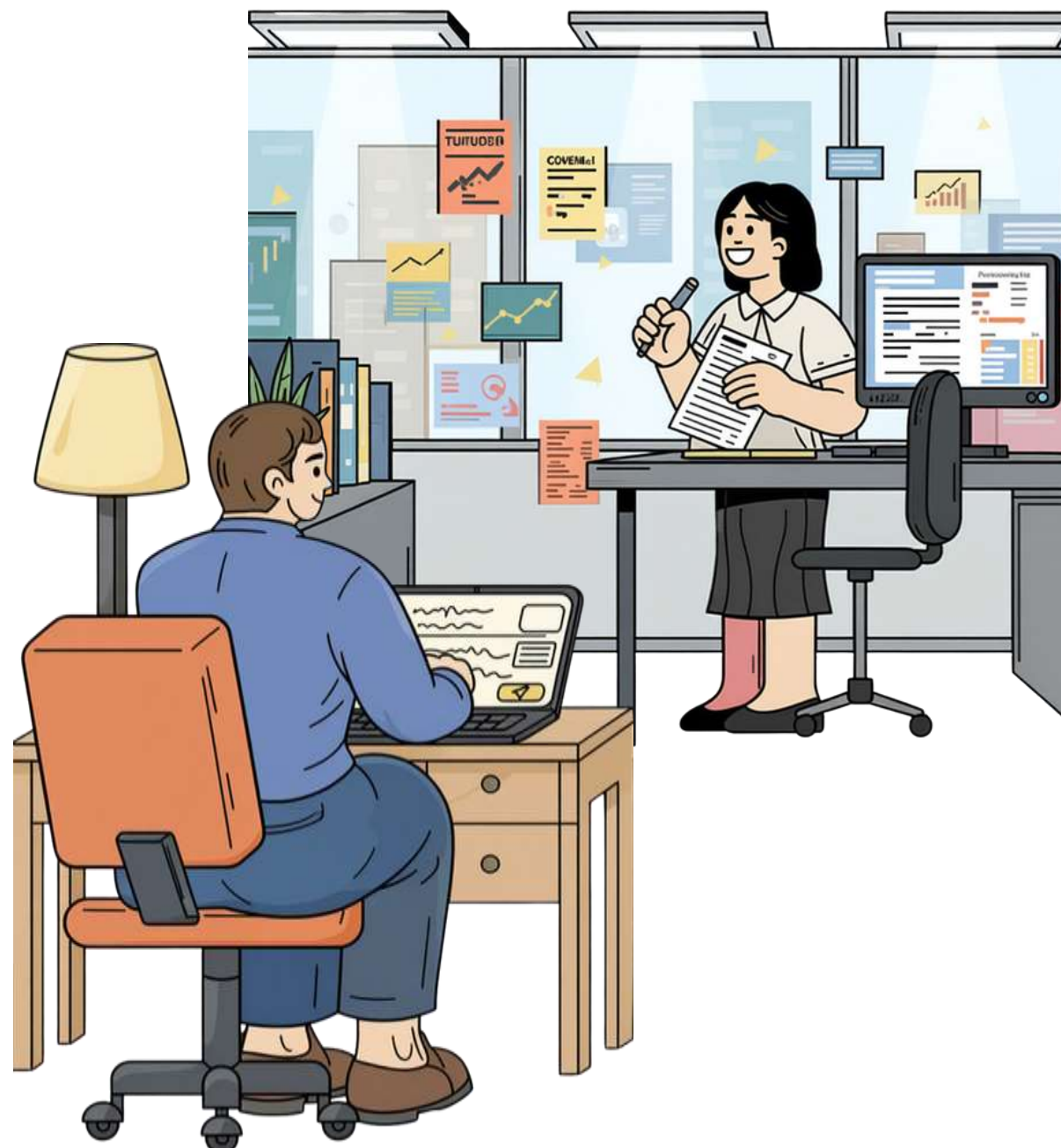
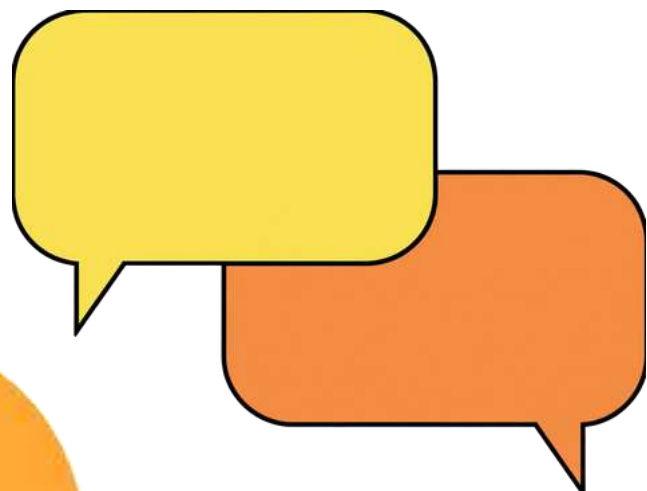
The APEEE is run by a Board of up to 21 volunteering parents from the different linguistic sections who serve as administrators.

MORNING



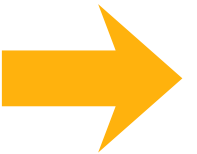
Arrival at school between 7:45 AM and 8:05 AM (54 buses)

AFTERNOON



2 departures (58 buses) on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday 15:20 (PM1 with priority given for M1 to P5) and 16:10 (PM2 for secondary pupils)

WED. NOON

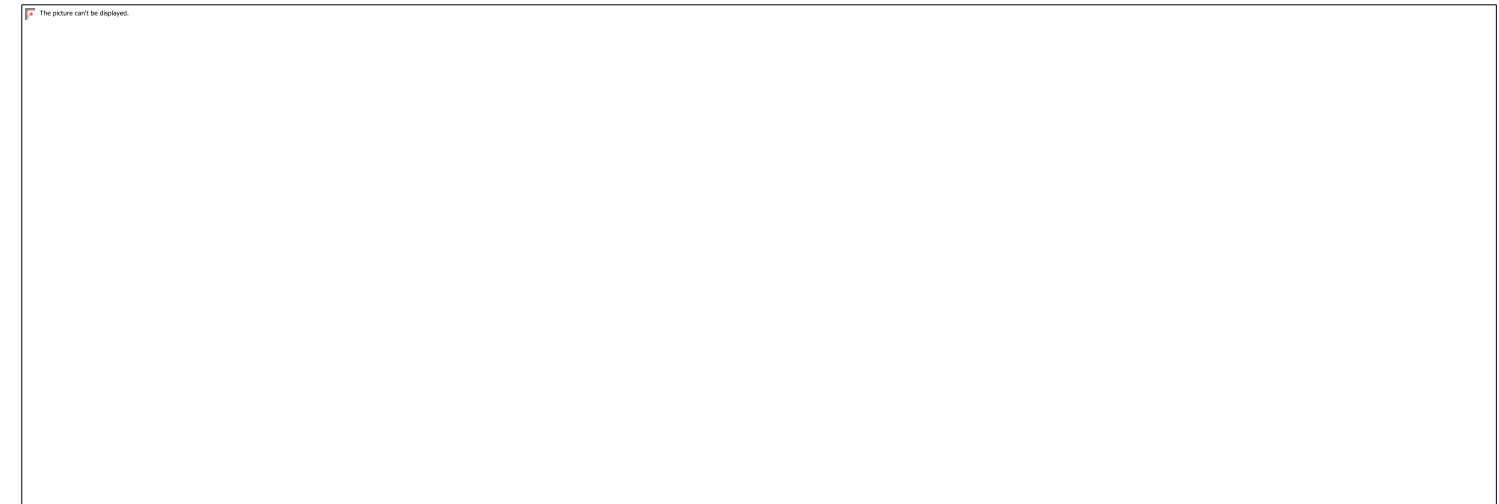


Departure for all (49 buses) 12:50 (buses to garderies leave at 13:30)

Only for students from M1 to P2, buses to garderies and merode.



Extracurricular related: possibility to use 2nd departure after extracurricular activities subject to seat availability

TRANSPORT SERVICE



HOW LONG ?

- Journey times depend on the routes, the number of stops (+/-350) and the Brussels traffic!
- The transport office tries to keep transport times to an average of 1h in the morning and 1h30 on the return trips.



WHO ?

- 11 different bus companies.
- We aim for a monitor, either adult or 15+ EEB4 student, in each bus (around 90 bus monitors in total).



FORMULA

- 100%: Home-school-home or home-school-garderie AM and PM.

- Occasional tickets can be purchased at least 24 hours in advance and are subject to seat availability!

If you are registered with the APEEE you can have access to the bus schedules and stops for the current year.

Paid in 3 instalments (each trimester).

CANTEEN OPTIONS

For the 2026-2027 school year, the Canteen service will introduce new registration options. Parents can enroll their children for 1 to 5 days per week.



WEDNESDAY REGISTRATIONS

Nursery and Primary (OIB daycare):

Pupils enrolled in the OIB daycare service benefit from a canteen meal included in the childcare fee. No additional registration for the canteen is required.

Nursery and Primary (Non-OIB daycare):

Parents who have not registered for the OIB Wednesday garderie but would like their child to have a hot meal can enroll in our new Wednesday service. The Canteen team collects pupils at the end of classes and brings them to the refectory where they are supervised during the meal. Pick-up time by parents is between **13:05 and 13:20**.

Secondary pupils:

Pupils registered on Wednesdays benefit from a more flexible schedule. As the staff canteen is used, they can have their hot meal at any time between **11:00 and 14:00**, depending on their timetable.

PICNIC AND CLUBS

When classes have outings, pupils registered for a hot meal receive a picnic bag with a packed lunch in the morning.

Secondary pupils participating in activities ('Clubs') during their usual canteen time also receive a packed lunch. Teachers organising the clubs communicate the list of pupils to the canteen office.

MENU

Our canteen menu is thoughtfully designed to offer a variety of balanced, healthy, and delicious meals for everyone. Each dish is carefully prepared by our talented chef and her dedicated team, who put genuine care, passion, and attention into every detail. 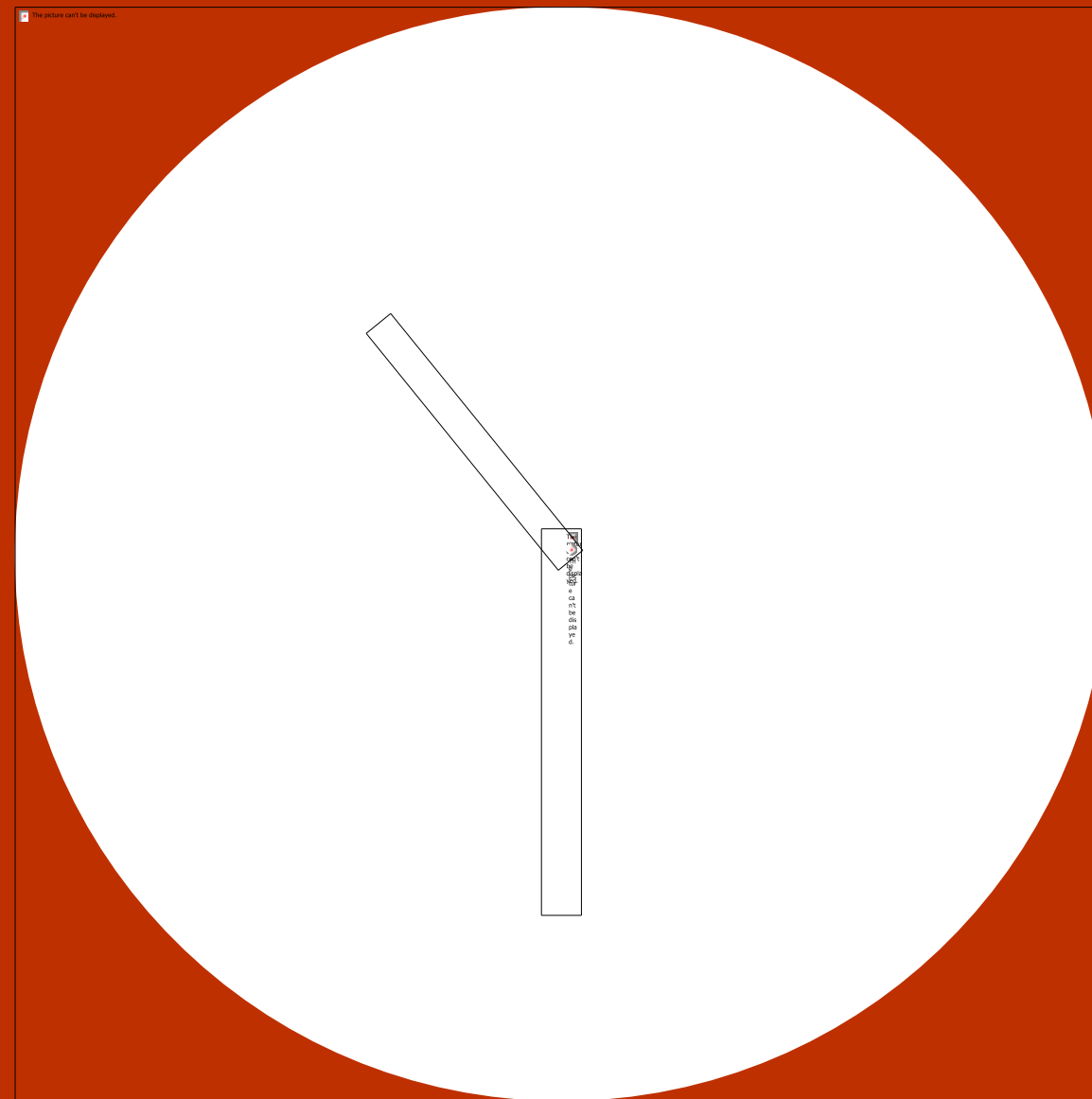

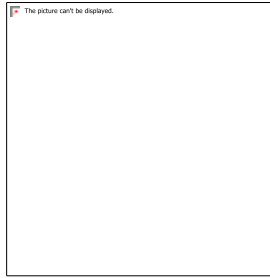

Camps for secondary students: Ski trip (Feb) & Summer Camp (last 2 weeks of school, end of June-beginning of July)

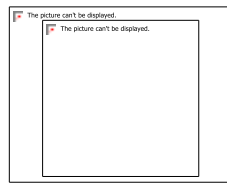

AFTER THE ACTIVITY ?

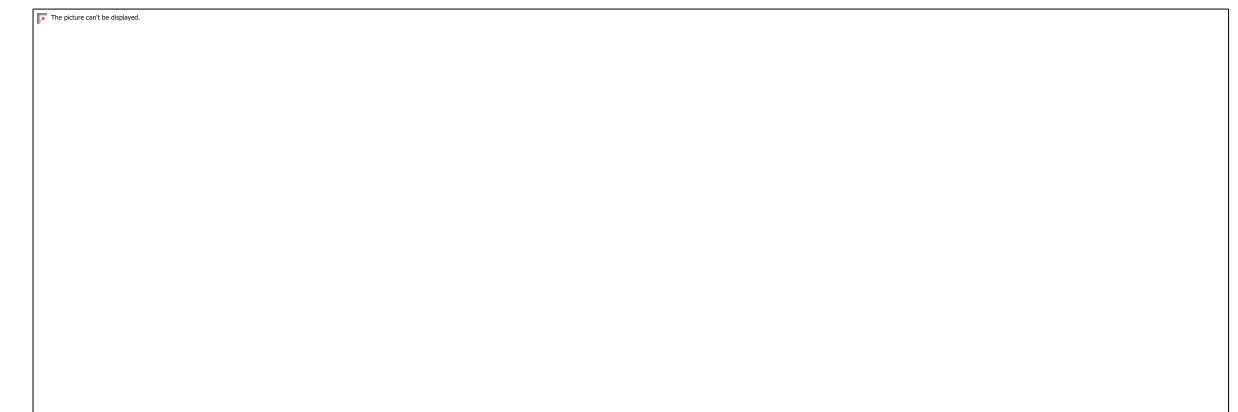
